They must obtain the instructor's signed approval. (If a course has multiple instructors, approval from any one instructor is sufficient.)
2. Students may not request additional instruction from either course's instructors or seek leave from one class due to attendance in the other. For exams, including quizzes, midterms, or finals, if there is a scheduling conflict with another course, students may not ask the instructor to reschedule, provide make-up exams, or offer special consideration for their grades.
